

Li Ning Brand Commitment

In order to achieve the ultimate goal of zero discharge of hazardous chemicals, Li Ning, as the only Chinese brand in ZDHC, commits to the following actions:

1. Beginning January 1, 2015, eliminate long-chain PFCs (i.e. C7, C8 and longer) from production processes of our supply chain;
2. Require the suppliers at all tiers to comply with Li Ning's Manufacturing Restricted Substances List (MRSL) and product Restricted Substances List (RSL) to manage inputs and outputs of our supply chain;
3. Ensure that at least 50% of all our 'wet process' suppliers make disclosure via IPE platform by no later than 30 June, 2015, and at least 80% of all our 'wet process' suppliers make disclosure via IPE platform by no later than 31 December, 2015;
4. Across all woven products, eliminate 80% of PFCs by no later than 31 December, 2015, 90% of PFCs by no later than 31 December, 2016, and 95% of PFCs by no later than 31 December, 2017;
5. Post on our public website the below statement of status of progress eliminating initial 11 priority hazardous chemical groups: Level 1) Contract language banning all hazardous chemical use across our supply-chain, re; each of the initial 11 priority hazardous chemical groups (including APEOs, PFCs, Phthalates).
